DUTIES

- A. Is familiar with the “Basic Skills and Knowledge Requirements of All Area Officers and Coordinators”.
- B. Serves as the primary communication between the groups and the World Service Office (WSO). Brings the views of the Area to the World Service Conference (WSC).
- C. Shares news and information from the WSO with the groups.
- D. Attends the WSC annually, representing the Area in all matters.
- E. Provides a written and oral report of the WSO activities during Area meetings; posts the report to the current Area communications platform within two (2) weeks of each meeting.
- F. Serves on a WSO Task Force, WSO Thought Force, WSO selected committee or WSO work group during the term.
- G. Attends the annual Southeast Regional Delegates Get Together (SERDGT); prepares timely topics for the SERDGT.
- H. Prepares a written “Sharing Area Highlights” report for presentation at the SERDGT and possible use as suggested by the WSC.
- I. Serves as President of the Board of Directors for Al-Anon Family Group – Tennessee and attends Board meetings as required.
- J. Keeps the WSO informed of AWSC officer’s, coordinator’s and DR’s contact information, including names, addresses, phone numbers and e-mail addresses. Coordinates this information with the Area Secretary.
- K. Maintains communication with Area Alternate Delegate.
- L. Submits to the WSO a Regional Trustee resume or notification of no candidate before the August 15 deadline.
- M. Informs the AWSC members that the *World Service Conference Summary* is available online to all Area Al-Anon members. May provide a hard copy to AWSC members.
- N. Informs members that *In-the-Loop* is available to all Area Al-Anon members.
- O. Participates on Area committees, thought forces, workgroups, and task forces if requested.
- P. Stays informed of Area activities in groups, Districts and AIS/LDC’s.
