 - Any groups that were formerly in 12C can reach out to Toby A. about their funds
 - Groups are also welcome to reach out to anyone at the Area or to Sarah S. to be connected with the right person who can help them with questions about transferring funds
4. It was pointed out that 12A was not present at the planning meeting, and have recently sent funds to the Area for safekeeping until the new Districts are established. Once these meetings begin attending their new District's monthly meeting, arrangements can be made for transferring the funds. 5. It was suggested that Districts acquire an EIN number to set up a bank account for their District, as opposed to using any one individual's SSN. It was also suggested that Districts maintain at least 2-3 signees on the bank account.
